MAINTENANCE ACTIVITY (1st Quarter of 2020)

There is no new Adopt-A-Forest program implemented in the 1st quarter of 2020 since donors last 3rd and 4th quarters of 2019 were already implemented in the 4th quarter of 2019, and the two new hectares donated by the new donors will be implemented in the 2nd quarter of 2020. Hence, this report will focus on the latest result of the maintenance activity of the planted seedlings.

- Maintenance Program for the planted seedlings is one of the important aspects of the Adopt-A-Forest Program. Maintenance activity ensures high survival rate of planted seedlings.
- The maintenance activity is being implemented every two (2) months from planting for the year one, every guarter for the year two and every semester for the year three. Maintenance may be extended into 4 to 5 years depending on the status of the planted trees.
- Maintenance Pass or Pass refers to the frequency of the planted seedlings being maintained through brushing, round weeding, re-staking and replanting. Adopt-A-Forest maintenance program has a total of 12 passes from year 1 to year 3 of the project. However, it can reach up to 14 to 16 passes for the 4th and 5th year depending on the evaluation or status of the planted trees on its 3rd year maintenance.
- BCWD employed three (3) registered foresters and seven (7) indigenous people/watershed settlers to do the validation and monitoring of the maintenance work conducted by the beneficiaries and other watershed related activities.

Maintenance of the four (4) hectares planted in November – December 2019

The 1st maintenance of the Adopt-A-Forest Program planted in November – December 2019 in partnership with Agusan del Norte Electric Cooperative (ANECO), PICE Agusan del Norte Chapter, JUCHEM Enterprises & BCWD Funded Project were completely validated on February 11, 2020, with a survival rate of 98.4%. It covered approximately four (4) hectares of an area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), and planted with 2,400 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare.

Maintenance of the two (2) hectares planted in September 2019

The 1st maintenance program of the Adopt-A-Forest Program planted in September 2019 in partnership with ANHS Class 85 (2nd donation) and Butuan Club of Southern California were completely validated on February 12, 2020, with a survival rate of 99.2 %. It covered approximately two (2) hectares of an area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), and planted with 1,200 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare.

The First Pass maintenance activity was completely validated on February 12, 2020. Maintenance activity included clear brushing, strip brushing and round weeding. At the time of validation/ inspection, the survival rate of the planted seedlings was 99.2 %. The original schedule of the 1st maintenance was in November 2019 but it was moved in January 2020 considering the beneficiary was not available to do the maintenance work on its original schedule.

Maintenance of the four (4) hectares planted in May 2019

The 4th maintenance program of the Adopt-A-Forest Program planted in May 2019 in partnership with Agusan Valley Masonic Lodge #160, ANHS Class 85, Inter-Office Employees & Business Credit Cooperative and Southern Gate Eagles Club were completely validated on February 12, 2020 with a survival rate of 100 %. It covered approximately four (4) hectares of area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), and planted with 2,400 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare.

The 4 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program was planted in May 2019. The maintenance activity is part of the program and to be implemented every two (2) months from planting for the year one to ensure high survival rate of planted seedlings. The Fourth Pass maintenance activity was completely validated on February 12, 2020. Maintenance activity included clear brushing, strip brushing, round weeding and replanting.

At the time of validation/inspection, the survival rate of the planted seedlings was at 100% since the partner beneficiary conducted replanting activity.

Our Adopt-A-Forest Program is now at 51 hectares with 33 generous donors. The 1st quarter of 2020 Adopt-A-Forest Program maintenance report shows that the average survival rate of planted seedlings is above 85%, which is the minimum survival rate set by BCWD for the said program.

On June 23, 2014, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was entered into by and between the DENR Regional Office (Caraga Region), BCWD as the Second Party, Father Saturnino Urios University Foundation Incorporated (FSUUFI) as the Third Party and District Constituency Office (DCO) first district of Agusan del Norte as the Fourth Party for the implementation of "One Hundred Thirty" (130) hectares National Greening Program in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR).

A sum of Two Million Four Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Pesos (\$\gamma 2,495,000.00) project cost for three (3) years shouldered by the DENR. BCWD also provided counterpart amounting to Four Million Eight Hundred Twenty Six Thousand and Two Hundred Fifty Pesos Only (₱4,826,250.00). Likewise, FSUUFI committed to provide financial support in the amount of Two Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Pesos Only (\$\frac{1}{2}99,000.00) for the intercropping of Abaca within the 130 hectares target.

DENR fund amounting to \$2,495,000.00 was downloaded to BCWD in tranche. BCWD implemented the project in partnership with the Antical Watershed Farmers Producers Cooperative (AWFPC) as the beneficiary of the said program.

The last maintenance activity was concluded in December 2017 with a survival rate of 90.32%. Some of the planted trees are now already around 10cm to 15cm diameter with average height of 15ft to 20ft.






