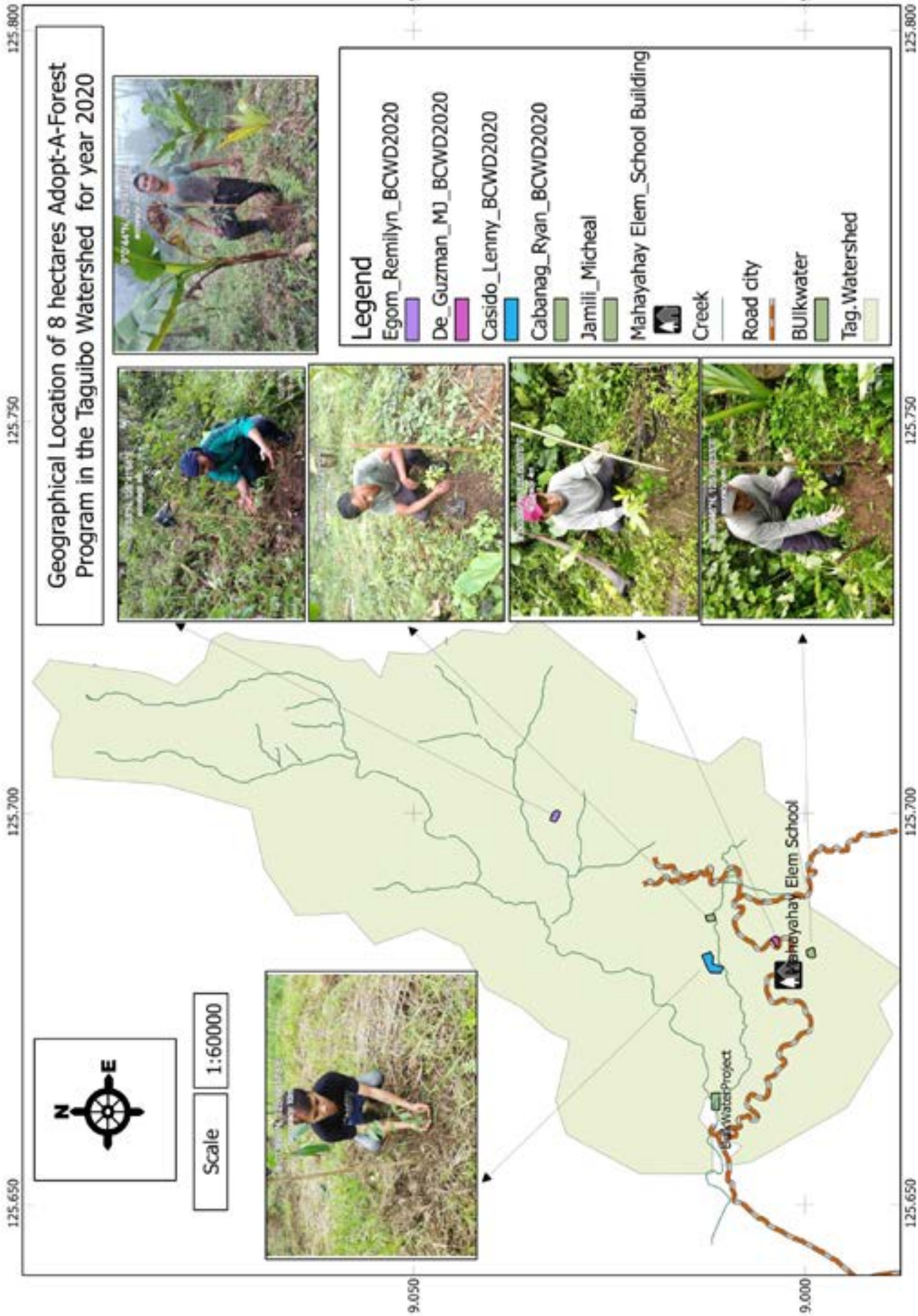

Donor Update

Dear Donor:

As of the 4th quarter of 2020, a total of 59 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program were implemented and maintained in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve. The Adopt-A-Forest Program maintenance report for this quarter shows that the average survival rate of the planted seedlings is above 85%, which is the minimum survival rate set by BCWD for the said program.

Site Preparation and Planting of the 8 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program for 4th Quarter of CY 2020 at Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve Area

There were only two (2) donors for the Adopt-A-Forest Program for 2020. Thus, in order to complete BCWD's commitment to reforest ten (10) hectares annually in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), BCWD implemented eight (8) hectares reforestation project through the Adopt-A-Forest Program using its own funds. The 8 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program is funded entirely by BCWD.

The Implementation of the 8 hectares BCWD Funded **Adopt-A-Forest** Program for CY 2020 was started on December 16, 2020 and completed the site preparation (brushing, stacking & hole digging) and planting on December 30, 2020. It covers approximately eight (8) hectares of area within the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), and planted with 4,800 seedlings (600/ha) of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Lanzones, Durian, Rambuttan, Narra and Tugas.

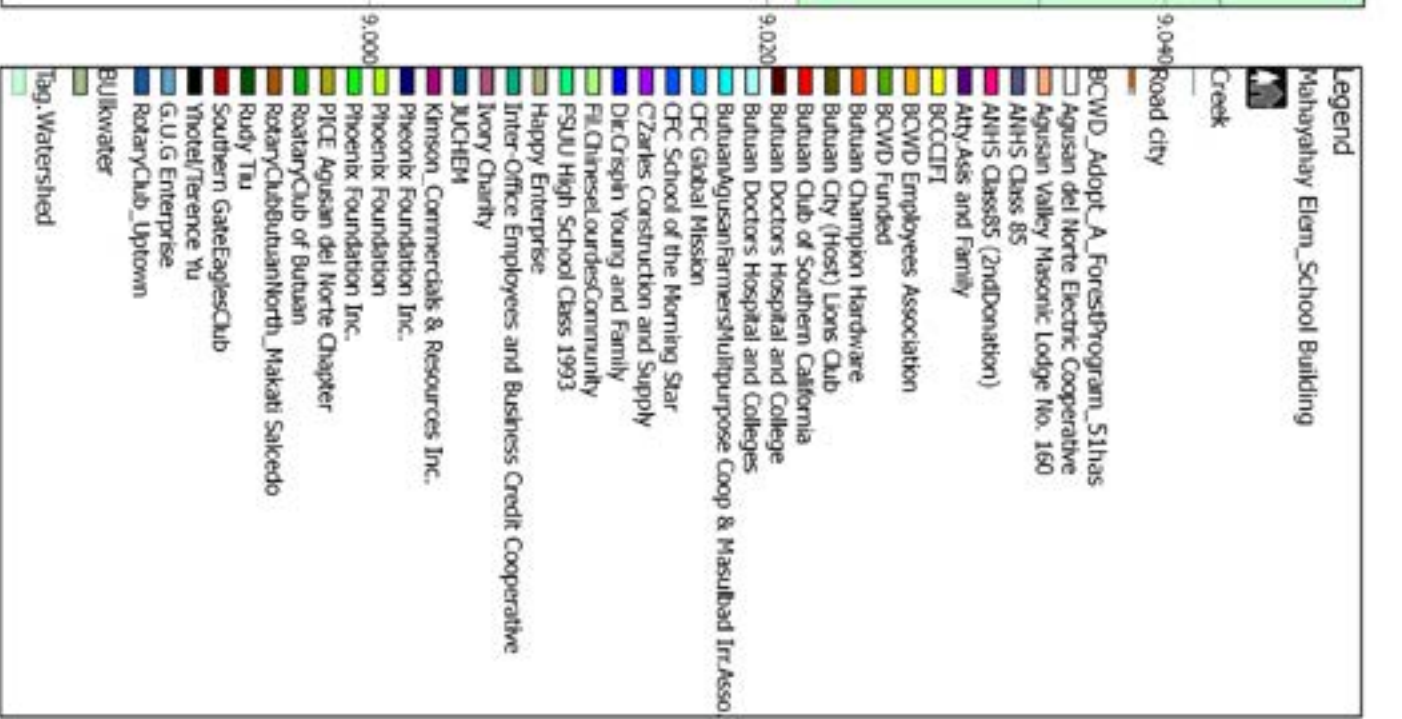
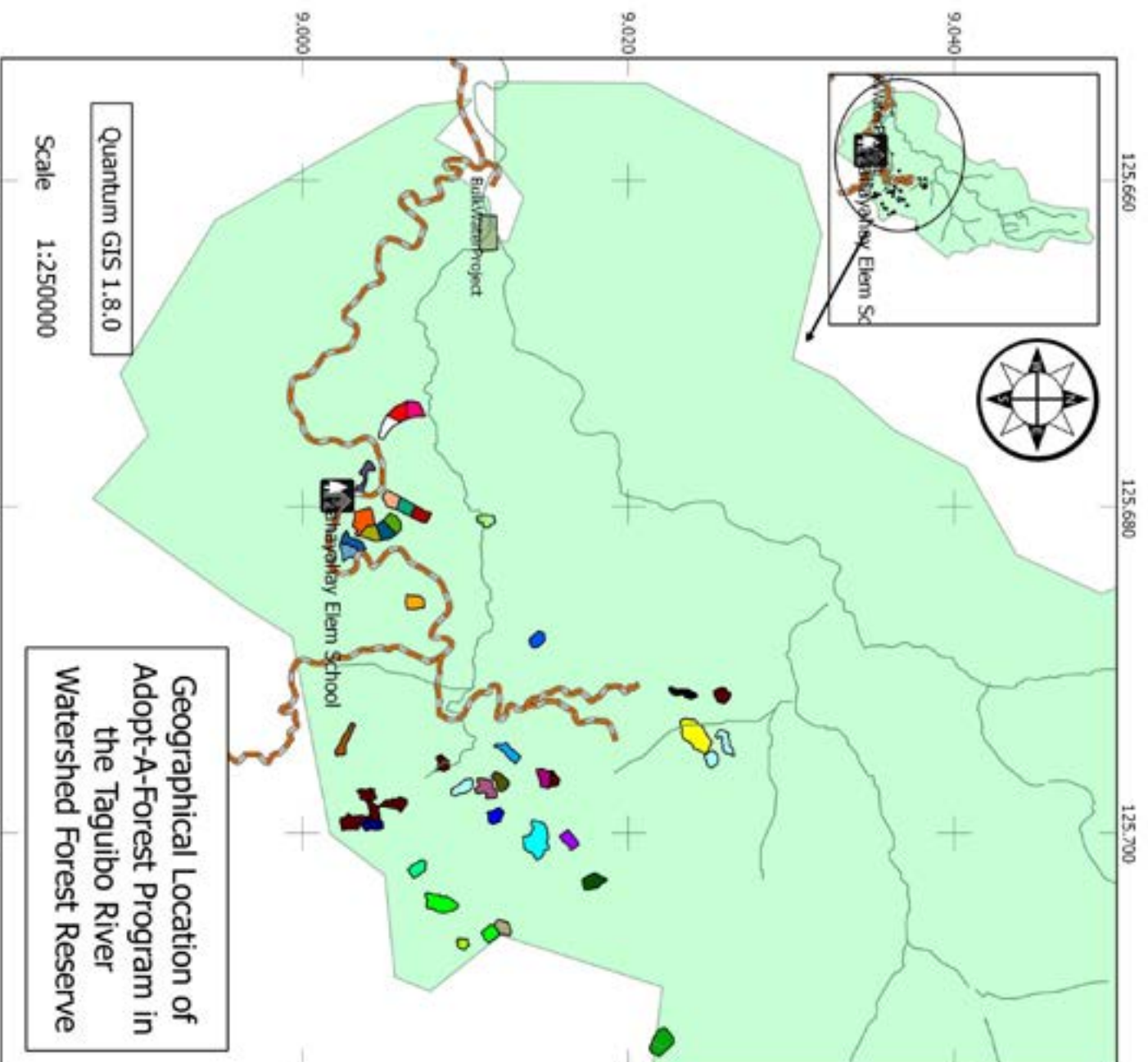


Conclusion:

BCWD implemented ten (10) hectares reforestation project in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve through the Adopt-A-Forest Program for the 4th quarter of 2020. BCWD committed to reforest ten (10) hectares in the Taguibo Watershed through its Adopt-A-Forest Program. However, there were only two (2) partner donors for the year 2020. Thus, BCWD funded the eight (8) hectares reforestation project using its own funds. This is to comply with the agency's commitment for the sustainable development of the Taguibo Watershed.

Based on the result of the maintenance activity for this quarter (4th quarter of 2020), the survival rate of the planted seedlings is above 85%, which is the minimum survival rate set by BCWD for its Adopt-A-Forest Program in the Taguibo Watershed.
