



Donor Update

Dear Donor:

As of 1st quarter of 2022, we have a total of 69 hectares reforestation project in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR) under the Adopt-A-Forest program with 35 generous donors. The result of the latest maintenance activity conducted shows more than 90% survival rate of the planted seedlings. Thus, meeting the 85% survival rate target of the said program.

The **3**rd **pass maintenance activity of the 1 hectare Adopt a Forest Program** planted on September 25, 2021 partnership with Agusan del Norte Electric Cooperative was completely validated on March 25, 2022 with a **survival rate of 96.50** %; it covers approximately one *(1)* hectare of area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), and planted with 600 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare. The 2nd pass maintenance activity was concluded on January 26, 2022 with a **survival rate of 97.67%**.





Watershed Symposium Activity

1st Quarter Watershed Community Symposium January 20, 2022

As part of the celebration of the Water District Week every last full week of January and the City Ordained Watershed Consciousness Week every 3rd week of January, the Butuan City Water District (BCWD) kicked off its quarterly Watershed Community Symposium last January 20, 2022. There was a total of 50 participants in the said activity including speakers and facilitators. Of the 50, 21 were female and 29 were male.

The Watershed Community Symposium is a quarterly IEC activity of BCWD to ensure the continuing awareness and education of watershed settlers and its continuum.
