SITE PREPARATION AND OUT-PLANTING

The site preparation and planting of the Adopt a Forest Program in partnership with Butuan Champion Hardware (Mr. and Mrs. Robert R. Ty) was concluded on December 31, 2018. Activities for the site preparation and planting include brushing, staking & hole-digging and planting of seedlings. It covers around two (2) hectares of area in Sitio Mahayahay, Anticala, Butuan City portion of Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR).

Approximately 1200 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Lanzones, Durian, Narra and Tugas were planted. The family of Rowena Durango Cea, resident of the said Sitio is the claimant of the planting site, likewise, the beneficiary of the Adopt-A-Forest Program.

Table 2.0 show the detailed result of the completed site preparation and out-planting activity.

The **3rd maintenance program** of the eight (8) hectares Adopt a Forest Program planted on May 2018 in partnership with Butuan City Chamber of Commerce & Industry Foundation Inc. (BCCCIFI), Rotary Club Butuan, Butuan City (HOST) Lions Club, C'Zarles Construction & Supply and FSUU High School Class 1993, and 2nd maintenance program of the one (1) hectare planted seedlings on July 2018 in partnership with BCWD Employees Association (BEA) were completely validated on November 21 and 23, 2018 respectively, with a survival rate of 96.0%. It covers approximately nine (9) hectares of area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR) planted with 5,400 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare.

At the time of validation/inspection, the survival rate of the planted seedlings was 96% which is higher compared to previous quarter which is at 93.69 % survival rate. The increase in survival rate was due to the scheduled replanting activity.

From its inception of the Adopt-A-Forest Program in 2013 up to the 1st quarter of 2019, there were a total of 42 hectares of land area adopted for reforestation. Donors were from private individuals and corporations, organizations and other agencies. There are a total of twenty six (26) donors for BCWD's Adopt-a-Forest Program. The donors comprise of three (3) private individuals/families, six (6) private corporations, two (2) schools, and fifteen (15) organizations.

Based on the 4th quarter of 2018 maintenance and validation activities conducted, it can be noticed that the survival rate of some planting sites slightly increased compared to the 3rd quarter of 2018. This is due to the scheduled replanting activity. The minimum requirement of survival rate set by BCWD is at 85%. The result of the maintenance activity for the 1st quarter of 2019 will reported in the 2nd quarter because some Adopt-A-Forest sites are still not safe due to the peace & order/insurgency situation in barangay Anticala, Butuan City.
