


Adopt-a-forest program

Dear Donor:

We have planted two (2) new hectares for our Adopt-a-Forest Program for the $3^{\rm rd}$ quarter of 2021. The new two (2) hectares are from ANHS Class 1981 (one hectare) and another one hectare from Agusan del Norte Electric Cooperative (ANECO) for their 2nd donation. A total of 61 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program were planted and maintained in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve, where the main source of BCWD's main water supply islocated,





